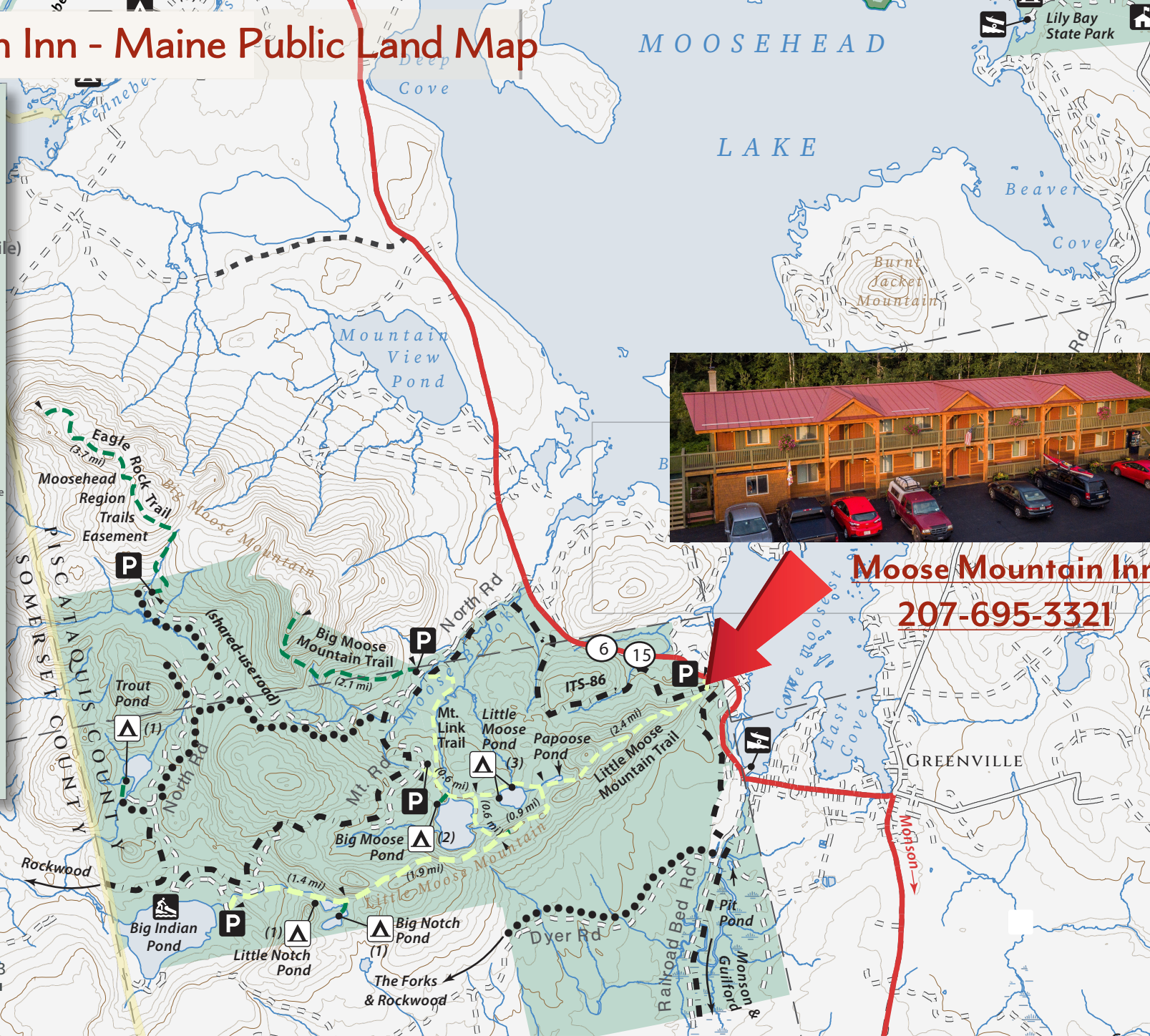


Moose Mountain Inn - Maine Public Land Map

Hike, Bike, ATV and Snowmobile Trails

Big Moose Mt. Trail (moderate, 2 miles)
Mooseheads highest Peak Climbs through Northern Hardwoods Forest . This and the cabin are remnants of the early fire lookout years. The trail continues following the historic watchmans route to the fire tower - the first in ' the nation was constructed here in 1905, replaced in 1919, and finally relocated in 2011 to the Moosehead Visitors Center. A ridge walk provides stunning views across Moosehead Lake to Mt. Katahdin.

Little Moose Mt. Hiking Trail (moderate, 6.6 miles)
from the **Moose Mountain Inn** trailhead off Route 6/15 rises through mixed woods as it travels towards a series of viewpoints; the first provides a picnic table and open view of the southern tip of Moosehead Lake. Further along the trail, periodic views open in a variety of directions. The trail is moderately steep and rocky with ledges. The junction with the loop trail around Big and Little Moose is reached at approximately 2.4 miles.

ATV & Snowmobile Trail is accessed directly from the Parking lot at the **Moose Mountain Inn** for hotel guests. The trail Takes you to the Moose Mountain loop, To Greenville, Shirley, Rockwood and towards The Forks. Varied terrain and Views of the Lake. Ample Trailer parking for hotel guests.

Bike Trails steep Leaving the **Moose Mountain Inn** by trail starts on a steep Multiuse trail or road access to the trailhead for Single track or connect to easy to moderate trails in greenville jct.
